SCOPE OF WORK

Erection of Hull Structure along with additional super structure as required for 5500T DWT Self Propelled RSV Class Type2 Barge in conformation to Technical Specification and Drawing (To be supplied by project department, BSCL).

1) General

It is the intension of BSCL to get approximately 1100 MT Erection of Hull Structure along with super structure as required for one no. 5500T DWT Self Propelled RSV Class Type2 Barge to be done at Jellingham Fabrication Yard of Burn Standard Company Limited (BSCL) near Nandigram, Purba Medinipur as per Technical Specifications and Drawing (to be supplied by Project Department , BSCL)

2) Contractor's Scope of Work

2.1 Assembly of Hull Structure along with super structure as required for 5500T DWT Self Propelled RSV Class Type2 Barge in conformation to Technical Specification & Drawing (to be supplied by Project Department, BSCL).

2.2 Job Details:-

- a) Fabrication, Erection and welding of Hull structures as per requisite drawing and specification
- b) Deckhouse fabrication and erection
- c) Erection, fabrication and complete welding of girders, Hawse pipe ,all seats for machinery and equipment as per drawings supplied by BSCL.
- d) Fabrication & Fitment of small but essential fittings /fabricated items as per the requirement of smooth operation of all systems of the vessel.
- e) Fitment of Hull outfitting items (including bought out and fabricated items) as per list in Annexure -A (enclosed)
- f) Inspection & Testing :-
 - 1) On completion of the welding of the Hull structure, each compartment/tank to be made ready for dry survey and clearance to be obtained from IRS surveyors.
 - 2) All compartments /tanks are to be checked for leakages by air pressure testing/water spray as the case may be and subsequent defects are to be rectified. Complete clearance is to be obtained from IRS for launching.
 - 3) Arrangement to be made for obtaining clearance of Radiography testing as directed by IRS surveyors.

2.3 Contractor's Responsibility

- a) Deployment of IRS approved Welders for integration, fabrication, erection & welding of the entire hull structure .
- b) Deployment of skilled manpower such as Fitter, Marker, Grinder, Erectors, Riggers and of other trades/areas as per requirement along with professionally qualified & competent Supervisors (minimum qualification -Engineering Diploma Holder) at the erection site.
- c) All necessary tools Tackles, Gas Cutting Equipment and Accessories, Safety Items, Grinding M/cs. Etc. for workmen shall be arranged by the party.
- 4) **BSCL's Responsibility**
 - a. Supply of Drawings and Technical Specifications, Steel materials as required, Welding Consumables, Paints, Grinding Wheels, Gas Cylinders, Welding M/cs., Tressels, Wooden Blocks, Wooden Packing & Wedges etc. shall be BSCL's responsibility.
 - b. Arrangement of Material handling equipment and facilities for fabrication and erection activities
 - c. To provide necessary bought out items

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INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS

1.0 CONTENT OF BIDS

1.1 Bid shall contain the following :-

- a) Earnest Money Deposit in the form of Demand Draft / Pay Order drawn in favour of BURN STANDARD CO. LTD. payable at KOLKATA.
- b) Cost of Tender for Rs 500/- in the form of Demand Draft/Pay Order in favour of BURN STANDARD CO. LTD. payable at KOLKATA
- c) Documentary evidence in support of credential, statutory documents, etc.
- d) List of Plant and Machinery available with the tenderers.
- e) P. F. and ESI registration certificate.
- f) Trade License from concerned authorities.
- g) Professional Tax clearance certificate from concerned authorities.
- h) Copy of Contract Labour license from competent authority.
- i) Copy of I.T Clearance certificate/PAN number
- j) All the pages of the tender document duly signed and sealed by the tenderers as a token of acceptance of all terms and conditions is to be returned along with the offer.
- k) Copy of Service Tax Registration Certificate.
- l) Copy of VAT Registration Certificate (If applicable)
- m) Copy of SSI Registration Certificate(If applicable)

1.2 Price Bid (Annexure-IV) shall contain the following :-

- b) Details of all taxes, duties applicable must be furnished.

2.0 RATES

2.1 Unit Rate/MT & Total Price for fabrication of Steel Block Sub Assy for RS Class Type-2 Propelled Vessels as per scope of work detailed in Annexure – I shall be quoted in “Price Bid” in Annexure – IV.

2.2 All taxes and duties applicable must be quoted with respective rates and amount. It is to be clearly understood that taxes and duties applicable as on date of bid opening and not indicated in the price Bid will be borne by the contractor. However, any statutory variation in rates and levy of new taxes and duties after bid opening during the currency of contract will be to BSCL account.

3.0 EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT(EMD)

3.1 The amount of earnest money deposit for this tender is Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lac only) which is to be deposited in the the form of Demand Draft / Pay Order drawn in favour of BURN STANDARD CO. LTD. payable at KOLKATA.

3.2 Offer without Earnest Money Deposit will be summarily rejected.

3.3 The units registered with DGS&D, SSI units registered with NSIC and PSU units may be exempted from submission of EMD on production of documentary evidence.

3.4 The EMD of unsuccessful bidders will be returned after finalization of the tender without any interest.

3.5 The EMD of successful tender will be returned after receipt of Security Deposit or will be adjusted against Security Deposit/Guarantee.

4 SECURITY DEPOSIT

4.2 Security deposit equivalent to five (5) percent of the total contract value shall have to be deposited by the successful tenderer within 15 days of receipt of LOI / Purchase order in the form of (a) Demand draft in favour of Burn Standard Company Ltd. Payable at KOLKATA or (b) Bank guarantee as per format provided by BSCL valid till completion of contract. Security shall bear no interest and will be forfeited for non-performance of the contract by the successful tenderer. However security deposit may be waived for SSI Unit registered with NSIC, PSU units, DGS&D approved sources. Security deposit may also be waived for proprietary items, original equipment supplier.

4.3 The company (BSCL) shall be entitled and shall be lawful on its part to forfeit the said security deposit in whole or in part in the event of any default, failure or neglect on the part of the contractor in the fulfillment or performance in all respects of the contract under reference or any other contract with the company or any part thereof to the satisfaction of the company and the company shall also be entitled to deduct from the said security deposit any loss or damage which the company may suffer or be put to by reason due to any act or other default, recoverable by the company from the contractor in respect of the contract under reference or any other contract and in either of the events aforesaid to call upon the contractor to maintain the said security deposit at its original limit by making further deposit, provided further that the company shall be entitled to recover such claim from any sum then due or which at any time thereafter may become due to the contract under this or any other contract with the company.

4.4 On due performance and completion of the contract in all respect the security deposit will be returned to the contractor without any interest on certification of concerned department.

4.4 A) **Essential Technical Qualification Requirement of Bidders**

- a) The bidder or joint venture(JV)partners may participate in the bid for which the relevant agreement should accompany with the offer.
- b) The bidders or JV Partners must have wide experience& expertise in successful construction of same type self propelled bargesor any sea going vesselsof at least 2500T DWT capacity or above during last five years.Credential (P.O. Copy & Performance Report) for performing similar type of job to be furnished with bid document.).
- c) The tenderers must have a team of required skill-mix particularly qualified welders as per IRS or ABS valid certification for undertaking similar type of Hull Structure Fabrication. Party must have professionally qualified Engineers & Technologists in their Management Team having minimum qualification of Graduation in Naval Architecture from reputed University / Institute.
- d) The tenderer should deploy Supervisors with due Technical Qualification(minimum Diploma Holder in Engineering)
- e) Supporting document fulfilling above mentioned technical eligibility criteria must be attached with the bid document without which the offer will be treated incomplete and shall be rejected.

B) Financial Criteria of Bidders

- a) Tenderers or it's JV partners & both altogether should have average yearly turnover of 1.00Cr in last 3 years excluding the current financial year. Audited Balance Sheet & Profit & Loss Account to be submitted as a proof of evidence.
- b) Party should have undertaken job of manufacturing similar Barge as mentioned in the Tender and have completed such job having value of 23 lacs or more during the current year.

5 Liquidated Damage Clause

In the event of late completion/if the completion schedule for this work is delayed beyond the stipulated completion period (except force majeure condition) for the reason attributed to you, BSCL reserves the right to recover from the contractor by way of Liquidated Damages equivalent to 0.5% of the total value including taxes & duties for every week or part thereof subject to maximum of 5% of the total value including all taxes and duties.

6 Classification, Inspection & Welder Test

- A) The vessel will be built under Indian Register of Shipping (IRS).
- B) Inspection will be carried out by BSCL/IRS as applicable.Any rectification/modification suggested by inspection Agency shall have to be carried out by the contractor without any extra cost.
- C) Stage inspection will be carried out as per Q.A.Plan.
- D) Non Destructive Testing of welds by Dye Penetration Test or Radiography to be carried out as per requirement of IRS. The contractor will assist by deploying their work force during testing.

7 Documents-Privacy & Confidentiality

The Contractor shall treat the work order and everything therein as private & confidential and shall not publish or issue to any third party any information, drawing, documents or photographs concerning the work and shall not use the site for the purpose of advertising except with our prior written consent.

8 Completion Period

The contractor shall mobilize the workforce immediately on receipt of the LOI/ work order. The fabrication & Erection job as per scope of work of this tender are to be completed within 06(Six) months from the date of receipt of order along with final approved drawings.

9 Project Planning & Co-ordination

A) Contractor shall submit the hull erection plan to BSCL as per requirement of the tender in 05(Five) days of receipt of the drawings/specification.

B) The Contractor must earmark a coordinator for close liaisoning with BSCL.

10 Idling Charges

No idling charges of labour and other workforces of contractor shall be paid by BSCL on whatsoever reason.

11 Payment Terms

a) 100% payment with full taxes & duties will be paid on completion certification of monthly bills submitted for erection of Hull Structure within seven days of receipt of the bill duly certified by Site Engineer/Manager or authorized representative of concerned department as delegated Burn Standard Company Ltd.,

12 OTHER TERMS & CONDITIONS

12.2 **Firm Rate** Quoted rates shall remain FIRM during pendency of contract and no escalation will be allowed.

12.3 **Paying Authority** : - Head of Accounts or authorised representatives of Accounts Department as delegated by competent authority of Burn Standard Co. Ltd., Head Office.

12.4 **Certifying Authority** : - Head of Departments or Authorised representatives of concerned departments as delegated by Unit Head of Burn Standard Co. Ltd.,

12.5 **Income Tax** : - Income Tax will be deducted at the prevailing rates from the bill of contractor and any increase in Income Tax or Surcharge thereto will be borne by Contractor.

12.6 **Compliance of Statutory Acts / Rules** : - The contractor shall comply with provisions of Laws & Rules in force from time to time which will be applicable to contract workmen including (a) Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act 1970 Contract Rules 1971 (b) Payment of Bonus Act 1948 (c) ESI Act 1948 (d) Workmen Compensation Act 1923 (e) Factory Act 1948 and (f) Central Minimum Wages Act and comply with the provisions of all other statutory labour legislation now in force and also that may be introduced in future and keep the company indemnified from any claim which may arise by reason of his default either wishfully or by ignorance.

12.7 Arbitration : - All questions, disputes or differences whatsoever arising between the BSCL and contractor or in relation to or in connection with the contract, either party may forthwith give notice to other in writing of the existence of such question, disputes or differences and the same shall be referred to the adjudicator of sole arbitrator. Chairman & Managing Director of BSCL shall have the right and authority to appoint any officer of the company as arbitrator not below the rank of a General Manager who is not directly connected with the order under the Arbitration & conciliation Act 1996. Any legal dispute that may arise will be settled within the jurisdiction of Court of Kolkata.

12.8 Validity of offer : - The offer should remain valid for (Sixty) 60 days from the opening date of tender,

12.9 Repeat Order & Quantity Variation Clause:- The quantity indicated are tentative and payment for this job shall be made for the actual quantities executed, measured and accepted by BSCL/IRS as per unit rate. However, BSCL management reserves the right to place repeat order for 75% & option clause 30%(+/-) of the offered quantity at the same rate and terms within the currency of the contract and contractor will be bound to accept the repeat order.

12.10 Termination of Contract and Risk Purchase:- In case of unsatisfactory progress of the work, BSCL reserves the right to terminate the contract without prior notice and award the same or balance to any other agency at the risk and cost of contractor.

13 No e- mail / FAX quotation will be accepted.

14 Tenderer sending tender by mail will do so, solely on their own risk and BSCL will not be responsible for any loss in transit or postal delay.

15 Incomplete tender or tenders submitted with qualified condition(s) at variance with special as well as General terms & conditions / instruction to bidders of this tender are liable to be rejected summarily.

16 In the event of BSCL's office remaining closed on the day of opening of the tender for any unforeseen reason, the tender shall be received up to 2.30 P.M. on the next working day of Burn Standard Co. Ltd. and will be opened at 3.00 P.M. thereafter in presence of such tenderer who may like to be present.

17 Tenderer shall have no right to issue Addenda to tender documents to qualify, amend supplement or delete any of the conditions, clauses or items therein after submission of the tender at BSCL.

18 The tenderer (henceforth shall be called as contractor) should strictly abide by the company's rule, regulation, and instruction issued from time to time in respect of all matters.

19 The safety of men and material will be sole responsibility of the contractor and the company shall in no way be held liable for any damage or loss to the property or injury to the men of the contractor. Contractor to take all the measures in respect of compliance of all statutory requirements.

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- 20 The contractor shall indemnifies the company against damage or loss to the property and injury to the workmen of the company when such damage, loss or injury is on account of any act on the part of contractor or his men.
- 21 All records and registers under the relevant statue will be maintained by the contractor and submitted for inspection for the company whenever required.
- 22 Contractor should have sufficient skilled man-power.For technical evaluation of the bid, contractor must furnish identity proof of dedicated skilled man power particularly, welders, markers & fitters,supervisors.
- 23 Contractor will have to fix-up the working hour to cater for the production target and BSCL will provide support services accordingly. No additional payment shall be entertained for extra hours of working.
- 24 All rates, price in the tender form should be quoted both in figures and in words. Tenders containing over written or erased rates are liable to be rejected.
- 25 It would be responsibility of the successful contractor to deduct and deposit employee's contribution, employer's contribution of provident fund and other related charges as per act and to deposit the same directly to P.F. authority as well as ESI will be deposited to the respective authority and due particular will be furnished to BSCL before releasing of next payment. The BSCL authorities shall entertain no disputes pertaining to P.F. deduction and deposit as well as ESI, if raised by the employees of the contractors.
- 26 Contractor shall have attendance register with his stamp on it at the factory gate where attendance of the contract workers is marked. At the end of the month, contractor shall submit a photo copy of attendance record duly signed and with official stamp on it.
- 27 Contractor shall submit bill on his letter head only.
- 28 Contractor shall maintain all type of records in respect of contract labour act.
- 29 Contractor shall ensure that labour is paid at least minimum wages.
- 30 In case ESI is not applicable, contractor to get his workers covered under workmen compensation plicy to ensure that compensation for death/injury under workmen compensation act 1923 is paid in accordance with law.
- 30.Contractor must not engage any workmen of more than 58 years age at any point of time.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

1.0 COMPLIANCE TO THE STATUTORY LAWS & RULES

- 1.1 The contractor shall comply with the provisions of Laws & Rules in force from time to time which will be applicable to the contract workmen such as :-
- a) Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act 1970 & Contract Rules 1971
 - b) Payment of Bonus Act 1948
 - c) Payment of Gratuity Act 1972
 - d) ESI Act 1948
 - e) Workmen Compensation Act 1923
 - f) Factory Act 1948
 - g) Central Government Minimum Wages Act
 - h) Employees Provident Fund & Misc. Provision Act 1952
 - i) Provisions of all other statutory labour legislation now in force and also that may be introduced in future and keep the company indemnified from any claim which may arise by reasons of contractor's default either willfully or by ignorance.

2.0 STOPPAGE OF WORK

- 2.1 Stoppage of work without prior notice is not admissible. However, in the event of any emergency or any other reason beyond the control of BSCL and in case company feels necessary, it may suspend or stop the work for certain period without any compensation.

3.0 GUARANTEE & PERFORMANCE BANK GUARANTEE FOR WORKMANSHIP

- 3.1 Guarantee for the fabrication work done by contractor shall be for a Period of 18(Eighteen) months from the date of acceptance of the block or 12 month from the date of Delivery of barge whichever is earlier. Contractor will be held responsible for any defect(s) arising out of said work within the guarantee period and the same is to be rectified / repaired as per direction of Engineer in-charge at their own cost immediately, failing which the defect will be rectified / repaired by the company at his risk and cost. The cost of such work is either to be recovered from the contractor's bill or from Security Deposit / Performance Guarantee.
- 3.2 Contractor has to submit Performance Guarantee by way of Bank Guarantee for a sum equivalent to ten percent (10%) of the value of contract towards any defect found during integration, workmanship etc valid for a period of 18months from the date of acceptance of block or 12 months from the date of delivery of barge whichever is earlier.

4.0 EXECUTION OF THE CONTRACT

- 4.1 Contractor must not engage any workmen of more than 58 years age at any point of time.
- 4.2 Contractor should produce the medical fitness certificate of each workmen engaged by him from a registered medical practitioner or by doctor authorised by BSCL. In case the company feels that any of the workmen is not fit, the company on its own can conduct the medical examination and the result of the examination shall be binding on the contractor.

- 4.3 Appropriate cleanliness, Industrial peace and discipline have to be maintained by the contractor and all outside and local problems have to be tackled by the contractor. BSCL shall not be concerned with these matters in any way.
- 4.4 Standard engineering practice (such as slag cleaning spatter cleaning, grinding, chipping, reaming, maintaining welding current /voltage as per WPS, maintaining dimensional tolerance as per product requirement etc.) and specific advice by IRS/BSCL are to be duly taken care of even if those are not specifically covered in the tender.

5.0 REDUCTION & REDISTRIBUTION OF ORDERED QUANTITY

- 5.1 Performance of the contractor shall be continuously reviewed by BSCL. In case it is observed that the contractor has failed to achieve the out turn the BSCL management reserves the right to reduce the ordered quantity up to 40% of the remaining quantity and offload the same to another contractor.

6.0 EVALUATION OF OFFER

After techno commercial evaluation of offers the Interse position of qualified bidders will be determined on the basis of total cost which will be inclusive of fabrication charges and Service Tax as applicable.

7.0 PREFERENCE TO MSME UNITS

- 7.1 Offer from MSME units will be considered for placement of order in accordance with the guidelines circulated vide Ministry of MSME, Govt. of India, Notification No. 503 dated 23.03.2012 and subsequent notifications, if any.
- 8.0 The BSCL management reserve the right to issue corrigendum / amendment to the tender / purchase order without assigning any reason whatsoever and the bidder / contractor will be bound to accept the same.
- 9.0 The BSCL management reserves the right to terminate the contract at any stage if considered necessary by the management without assigning any reason whatsoever for greater interest of the company and such action cannot be challenged by the tenderer / supplier.
- 10.0 Past performance of the contractor will be taken into consideration at the time of finalizing the order. BSCL management reserves the right to ignore the offer of the bidders whose past performance is not satisfactory.
- 11.0 In case the offer is not accepted by BSCL, the tenderer shall not be entitled to claim any cost, charges, expenses made for submission of offer.
